Federal Project No. RPSTPLE-6092 (061) Regional Bike Map Update 2014

County of Butte, State of California

The Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG) will receive quotations for the above project at the office of the Butte County Association of Governments, 2580 Sierra Sunrise Terrace, Suite 100 until 02:00 PM, (PST), November 21, 2013. The envelope enclosing the quotation submittal shall be clearly marked "Federal Project No. RPSTPLE-6092 (061), "Regional Bike Map Update 2014".

No quotation will be considered unless it is made on the quote form furnished by BCAG. Due to the federal funding being used for this project, BCAG is required to be under contract for this project by December 15, 2013, however, the reproduction of the map will not occur until likely May 2014.

Reproduction Specification:

The Vendor shall reproduce the Regional Bike Map which will be provided by BCAG in electronic form in an Adobe PDF format. The reproduction shall consist of a 4 color process, 2 sides, trim and fold to 4.375 inches by 9.375 inches, delivered in cartons to the BCAG offices. The map itself is 28 inches by 25.5 inches. The reproduced map shall consist of being printed on a water-proof and tear-resistant paper (61# Polyart or equivalent). The quantities are to be reproduced in two equal intervals. **The final version of the map is expected to be completed by May 2014**. Interval 1 shall be printed and delivered to BCAG within five weeks after receipt of the final version of the map. Interval 2 shall be printed approximately 18 months later and be delivered within five weeks after receipt of the final version of the map. Interval 2 printing reproduction shall be determined by BCAG. This will allow for corrections or minor updates that may occur to the map.

This contract is subject to state contract nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code, Section 12990.

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

These quantities are estimates for the purposes of bidding. BCAG reserves the right to increase or decrease the estimated quantities by twenty five percent (25%) with no adjustments to the unit price bid by the vendor.

The successful bidder, at bidder's own expense, shall furnish a faithful performance bond and a payment bond each in an amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the total bid, respectively. The bonds shall be provided to BCAG at the time of execution of contract.

In its discretion, BCAG or its designee may reject any and all quotations presented, may accept an item or group of items of any quotation, may modify or cancel in whole or in part the notice inviting quotation, and may determine to re-advertise for bids. Similarly, BCAG reserves the right to waive informalities and minor irregularities in any quotation received.

If two or more bids received are for the same total amount or unit price, quality and service being equal, BCAG or its designee may accept the one it chooses or accepts the lowest quotation after negotiation with tie quotations.

Quotations will be required to set forth the price of the items quoted upon, the total sales and use taxes that will be due on the purchase or use of the items quoted upon, and a total figure for the price plus tax. Any difference between the taxes shown on the quotation as the total figure and that actually due shall be the responsibility of the bidder.

No charge for delivery, shipping, parcel post, packing, insurance, license fees, permits, or for any other purpose will be paid by BCAG unless expressly included and itemized in the quotation.

BCAG affirms that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation.

Pursuant to Section 22300, Public Contracts Code, the Contractor may elect to receive one hundred percent (100%) of payments due under the contract from time to time without retention of any portion of the payment by the public agency in accordance with the provisions of Section 22300 of the Public Contracts Code. Such securities, if deposited by the Contractor, shall be valued by the public agency's finance director (treasurer), whose decision on valuation of the securities shall be final.

The Notice to Bidders, Special Provisions, Bid Documents, Contract Forms, and Attachments for the work are dated November 1, 2013 and are entitled:

Notice to Bidders

The bidder shall set forth for each unit basis item of work a unit price and a total for the item, and for each lump sum item a total for the item, all in clearly legible figures in the respective spaces provided for that purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Item Total" column shall be the product of the unit price bid and the estimated quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for the item, the item price shall prevail; provided, however, if the amount set forth as an item price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause or is omitted, or in the case of unit basis items is the same amount as the entry in the "Total" column, then the amount set forth in the "Total" column for the item shall prevail in accordance with the following:

- A. As to lump sum items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be the item price.
- B. As to unit basis items, the amount set forth in the "Total" column shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the item price.

If both the unit price and the item total are unreadable or otherwise unclear, or are omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular. Likewise if the item total for a lump sum item is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is

omitted, the bid may be deemed irregular unless the project being bid has only a single item and a clear, readable total bid is provided.

The foregoing provisions for the resolution of specific irregularities cannot be so comprehensive as to cover every omission, inconsistency, error or other irregularity which may occur in a bid. Any situation not specifically provided for will be determined in the discretion of BCAG, and that discretion will be exercised in the manner deemed by BCAG to best protect the public interest in the prompt and economical completion of the work. BCAG reserves the right to reject all bids.

The award of the contract, if it be awarded, will be to the lowest responsible, responsive bidder based upon the base bid whose bid complies with all the requirements prescribed.

If this proposal shall be accepted and the undersigned shall fail to enter into the contract and to furnish the two bonds in the sums to be determined as aforesaid with surety satisfaction to BCAG, within ten (10) days, not including Sundays and legal holidays, after the bidder has received notice from the BCAG Programming Manager that the contract has been awarded, BCAG, at its option, may determine that the bidder has abandoned the contract, and thereupon this proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void and the forfeiture of such security accompanying this proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of BCAG.
