Subject: Butte County Association of Governments' Administrative Modifications No. 02 to the 2019 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Dear Mr. Carson, Mr. Matley, and Mr. Aljabiry:

On August 4, 2015, with the acknowledgment of the Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG) Board, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) delegated to the BCAG Executive Director the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP)/Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This delegated authority is in accordance with the FSTIP/FTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification procedures.

The BCAG Executive Director has completed review of Administrative Modification No. 02 to the 2019 FTIP. The Executive Director finds that these proposed changes are consistent with the FTIP Amendment Policy adopted by the BCAG Board; therefore, approves these changes. BCAG certifies that the projects included in this modification are not included in any other amendment or modification to the 2019 FTIP currently out for public review or approval. The BCAG staff reviewed the requests and has agreed to make administrative revisions to the 2019 FTIP reflecting changes to the projects below:

**Modification 02 for Various Local Projects:**

**1. SR 70 Passing Lanes (Segment 1) – Caltrans District 03**

The purpose of this modification was to make a minor description adjustment to ensure consistency between the STIP and SHOPP. In addition, a minor financial adjustment with updated project costs was made for the construction component to reflect project cost savings. These changes reflect a

cost savings from RIP and IIP funds from \$5.4 million to \$3.7 million each. A revised total project changed from \$48.62 million to \$45.22 million. No other modifications were made.

2. **SR 99 Bikeway Phase 4 Improvements** BCAG staff made technical corrections to this project as a result of an oversight by BCAG at time of adoption. Funding to reflect a time extension approved by the CTC should have resulted in funds being moved into appropriate fiscal year within 4-year TIP period. ATP and CMAQ funds should have been extended from FY 17/18 to 18/19 and were not. This technical correction identifies the ATP funds in 18/19 in order to meet extension delivery requirements approved by the CTC. CMAQ funds are also required to be moved to FY 20/21 to ensure financial constraint. Local agency will be required to utilize local AC and be reimbursed when CMAQ funds are available. Total project cost of \$2,467,500 does not change, nor does delivery schedule.
3. **Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction - HBP Program** This project was modified to be consistent with the March 22, 2019 HBP list provided by Caltrans. The change includes a minor financial change to add \$209,000 in the 2018/19 FY. The total funding in the 4-year TIP period changed from \$938,400 to \$1,140,000. The backup list changed from 10 projects to a total of 8 projects. Those projects removed identified funding in the “beyond” years outside of the TIP period. No other changes were made.
4. **Grouped Projects for Safety Improvements - SHOPP Mobility Program** The purpose of this modification was to identify minor scope modification in the project description. A PCR was approved at the June 2019 CTC meeting to change postmiles and project description. These changes include:  
“SR 99 Southgate Ave to Garner Lane. Install Traffic Management System (TSM) elements. Postmiles 29.3/T37.8”. No change in schedule or funding.
5. **Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction - SHOPP Bridge Program** This modification updates the project description and funding as identified in the PCR approved by the CTC at their June 2019 meeting (Amend#18H-010). OH330 increase RW-Cap and decrease CON-Cap. OF290 increase RW-Cap and CON-Cap.
  1. SR 99 north of Broyles Rd. Bridge rail upgrade at 6 locations - \$7.076m in FY 19/20. EA OH330
  2. SR 99 near Richvale at Cottonwood Creek Bridge #12-0120. Replace and realign scour-critical bridge - \$13.230m in FY 19/20. EA OF290

BCAG concurs with the approval of these administrative modifications because:

- 1) The change in total funding is less than 40% for each project;
- 2) The projects are existing projects already included in the regional emissions analysis as appropriate and therefore does not warrant a new analysis; and
- 3) The proposed project changes does not interfere with timely implementation of any approved TCMs.

Revisions have been made to California Transportation Improvement Program (CTIPS) database and are reflected in the enclosure. This administrative modification relies on the FSTIP financial capacity. The financial constrain documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this administrative modification in the next formal amendment. It should be noted that the changes to these projects does not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, Administrative Modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration or Caltrans approval. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, the Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration that this Administrative Modification has taken place.
