

SR 99 GRIDLEY WIDENING

Purpose: Improve operations and safety on State Route 99 from East Gridley Road to Hazel Street.

Description: This project improves the highway to a full five-lane highway section with a continuous two-way left turn lane and 1.5-meter (5 ft.) shoulders from East Gridley Road to Spruce Street and improves roadside drainage.

Funding: Regional Improvement Program (RIP)
Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ – FHWA)

Sponsoring Agencies: Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG)
City of Gridley
California Department of Transportation

Status:

The consultant is preparing final Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) and Caltrans is acquiring the necessary right of way for construction of the project. BCAG is working with the City of Gridley to underground the overhead phone and cable facilities along the roadway as a separate project.

Begin right of way acquisition

Schedule:	Acquire Right of Way	December 2007
	Begin Construction	Summer 2008

Cost: Construction estimated at \$3.8 million
