- Started work with Siskiyou County for local government support
- Projects continue with Paradise Park & Rec District and Rebuild Paradise

CalFire –

- Nick is assisting with pre-fire engineering.
- Hydrant data has been compiled and will be available in engines
- State Responsibility Areas will be released April 1st.
- Local Response Areas update just started and estimated to take 18 months.
