2004 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Honorable Chairperson:

The Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG) is the federally designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and the state designated Regional Transportation Planning Agency (RTPA) serving Butte County. BCAG is responsible for developing all state and federal transportation plans and programming documents that are necessary to program transportation funds within the region.

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BCAG is committed to developing Government-to-Government relationships with the Tribal Governments within the Butte County region. In the past, BCAG extended an invitation to your Tribe to attend our Transportation Advisory Committee (TAC), which typically meets on a monthly basis. The purpose of the TAC is to review and discuss BCAG's transportation planning activities and issues in a multi jurisdictional planning forum. Representatives from Caltrans and the Cities and County participate on the TAC.

BCAG staff is currently developing the long-range "Regional Transportation Plan" for Butte County. This is a federally required long-range transportation-planning document that is updated every three years. The purpose of this document is to identify Butte County's long-term (20-25 years) transportation needs for all travel modes.

In addition, BCAG staff is also developing the short-range "Federal Transportation Improvement Program" for Butte County. This document identifies the programming of

federal transportation dollars over the next three federal fiscal years. Of particular interest right now is the new programming of Transportation Enhancements projects and new Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality projects.

We have attached for your record a public notice that will be placed in the local newspaper informing the public of these documents. We welcome any input you may have. If you prefer, I can arrange for BCAG staff to provide your Tribe with a workshop. All material will be posted on the Internet at BCAG's website at www.bcag.org as it is developed.
