Meeting Summary

City/County/Agency GIS Programs

Butte County GIS Division –

- Thompson and Park fires (datasets, web maps, etc.)
- Other services for code enforcement and water
- Maintenance of evacuation zones and updated info for public safety shut offs

City of Chico –

- Brad Pierce will be retiring in December
- Completed implementation of Portal for ArcGIS
- Web map development for street sweeping and leaf pickup
- Utilizing Experience Builder for generating quick maps

Town of Paradise –

- Completing grant deeds and as-build tracking datasets
- Working with County to receive old as-builds
- Exploring Field Maps and Survey 1-2-3 for field collections

CalFire –

- Nick Burtman is the new pre-fire engineer to the area
- Nick will handle local projects, and Spencer will be working on state projects
- Community Wildfire Protection Plan update in-progress
 - Still requesting projects from local jurisdictions
 - Final approval is expected in March 2025
- Local Response Areas update in-progress
 - FRAP model being used to establish new areas
 - Could impact local building codes

- Draft Map release expected in Dec 2024 with final approval in Spring 2025

Chico State –

- Working with Tehama Co to add ArcGIS online
- Paradise Park & Recreation District mapping work continues
- Assisting City of Chico with transition to Enterprise
- Updating roads layer to include FHWA classifications
- Thomas Mitchum will be new tribal liaison, working with Butte RCD and Fire Safe Council to explore GIS for tribes.

BCAG –

- On-going annual regional datasets update with Chico State
- Requesting local development projects in 2025

LUCA and Census Address Files

- Census will begin LUCA and Master Address File (MAF) updates for 2030 in 2027
- Local jurisdictions and tribes should begin preparing <https://www.census.gov/programs-surveys/decennial-census/decade/2030/planning-management/where/2030-census-luca.html>
- CA has not committed to providing funding assistance at this time, but will explore next year
