Meeting Summary

City/County/Agency GIS Programs

City of Chico –

- Continued coordination with Chico State for Trakit work
- Review and clean-up of City datasets
- GIS Division is assisting with [RapidView](#) implementation and maintenance
- Continuing migration to [Experience Builder](#)
- Developing internal web map for ADA review and inventory

Butte County GIS Division –

- Migrating Web Apps to Experience Builder – recently completed staff training
- Assessor has added additional mappers and parcel edits have accelerated
- [Genasys Protect](#) contract is in process and expected to be complete by summer

Butte County Public Works –

- Recently completed ArcGIS Pro transition
- Coordinating with GIS Division on LAFCO annexations

Chico State –

- Providing GIS support role for local jurisdictions
- Initiating work to update datasets for Butte County Mosquito and Vector Control
- Approached by City of Gridley to assist with data maintenance
- Continuing Paradise Parks & Rec mapping
- Transitioning Rebuild Paradise mapping applications to Town of Paradise
- Assisting City of Chico with SDE migration

CalFire –

- Field maps update for wildland pre-plan
- Automatic Aid maps being updated
- CalFire is initiating work to update facilities dataset
- Fuels reduction inventory being completed with Survey 1-2-3
- Community Wildfire Protection Plan annual updates in-progress

BCAG –

- Incorporated Park Fire destroyed units into annual land use updates
- Fall regional traffic counts completed, spring began in February
- Coordinated with local jurisdictions on Planned Development projects layer update

Census Block Boundary Suggestion Project (BBSP)

- BCAG will be coordinating with local agencies to review census blocks
- BBSP timeline is February – May 2026
- Butte County and City of Chico will consider reviewing own blocks
- BCAG will compile and submit to state

Regional Roads Discussion

- BCAG is working on follow-up items from last meeting
 - BCAG/GIC re-establishing new road contacts with local jurisdictions
 - Error submittal procedure
 - GIC revising process for reviewing parcel changes for new roads
 - Feature classification clean-up
- NextGen 911 put on hold by state
