Subject: Butte County Association of Governments' Administrative Modifications No. 05 to the 2025 Federal Transportation Improvement Program

Dear Mr. Kang, Mr. Valencia and Ms. Ruan,

On August 4, 2015, with the acknowledgment of the Butte County Association of Governments (BCAG) Board, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) delegated to the BCAG Executive Director the authority to approve Administrative Modifications to the Federal Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (FSTIP)/Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP). This delegated authority is in accordance with the FSTIP/FTIP Amendment and Administrative Modification procedures.

The BCAG Executive Director has completed a review of Administrative Modification No. 05 to the 2025 FTIP. The Executive Director finds that these proposed changes are consistent with the FTIP Amendment Policy adopted by the BCAG Board and therefore approves these changes. BCAG certifies that the projects included in this modification are not included in any other amendment or modification to the 2025 FTIP currently out for public review or approval. BCAG has made the following administrative revisions to the projects in the 2025 FTIP described below:

UPDATES TO EXISTING EXEMPT FTIP PROJECTS & GROUPED LISTINGS:

- 1. Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction (HBP)** – The purpose of this modification was to update the grouped listing for Butte County HBP Bridge Projects per Caltrans HQ list dated 03/18/2026. A minor financial adjustment was made for existing bridge projects. No other changes were made.

- 2. Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 Program Grouped Listing** – The purpose of this modification was to update the grouped listing for FTA Section 5310 vehicles approved on 03/19/2026 by the California Transportation Commission (CTC) for 1 large bus and 2 minivans. A total of \$345,100 was added with \$50,900 in federal toll credits for the 2024/25 program. No other changes were made.
- 3. Roe Rd Extension Phase 2 Project – Town of Paradise**. The purpose of this modification was to update the project description with a minor scope change as approved by the California Transportation Commission on 03/19/2026. The scope replaced a proposed Class 1 multi-use path with Class II bike lanes on each side of the new two-lane roadway. No other changes were made.
- 4. Grouped Projects for Bridge Rehabilitation and Reconstruction – SHOPP Bridge Program - Caltrans**. The purpose of this modification was to update the Grouped Listing with EA ON160, for State Route 70 Near Oroville Project. This modification adds \$2,530,000 to rehabilitate the bridge deck and upgrade the guardrail. This project was approved by the California Transportation Commission on 03/19/2026.
- 5. Grouped Projects for Pavement Resurfacing and/or Rehabilitation – SHOPP Roadway Preservation - Caltrans**. The purpose of this modification was to update the Grouped Listing with EA ON440 for State Route 99 Near Chico Project from near Eaton Rd Overcrossing to Tehama County line. This modification adds \$5,590,000 in the 4 year period of the FTIP for rehabilitate the pavement, drainage systems, update guardrails, signs, Transportation Management System (TMS) elements, improve the intersection and upgrade to ADA standards. This project was approved by the California Transportation Commission on 03/19/2026.

BCAG concurs with the approval of these administrative modifications because:

- 1) The change in total funding is within the allowable threshold identified in the FSTIP/FTIP Administrative Modification and Amendment Procedures;
- 2) The projects are existing projects already included in the regional emissions analysis as appropriate and therefore does not warrant a new analysis; and
- 3) The proposed project changes do not interfere with timely implementation of any approved TCMs.

Revisions have been made to California Transportation Improvement Program (CTIPS) database and are reflected in the enclosure. This administrative modification relies on the FSTIP financial capacity. The financial constrain documentation will be updated to reflect changes made by this

administrative modification in the next formal amendment. It should be noted that the changes to these projects does not require a re-determination of the air quality conformity analysis.

Under the delegated authority received from Caltrans, Administrative Modifications do not require Federal Highway Administration, Federal Transit Administration or Caltrans approval. The purpose of this letter is to notify Caltrans, the Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration that this Administrative Modification has taken place.
